Financial Help

General Assistance and CalWORKs: Immediate help with housing, food, utilities, clothing and medical care for those with little or no resources. Call <u>760-924-1770</u> to talk to a Mono County eligibility worker.

Paid Sick Days: If your workplace is still open and you need time off, ask your employer about Paid Sick Leave, including new rights to paid sick days due to the coronavirus.

Unemployment: Payments to workers who lose job or have hours reduced, through no fault of their own. Generally, not available to undocumented workers (must have legal work status). Apply online at edd.ca.gov/unemployment or by phone, English: 1-800-300-5616 / Spanish: 1-800-326-8937.

Disability (SDI): Payments to workers unable to work due to medical quarantine or illness related to COVID-19. Available to undocumented workers. Application must be certified by a medical professional, so contact your doctor to apply or visit SDI Online at www.edd.ca.gov/disability/SDI_Online.htm.

Paid Family Leave: Payments to workers unable to work due to caring for an ill or quarantined family member. Available to undocumented workers. Application must be certified by a medical professional, so contact your doctor to apply or visit SDI Online at www.edd.ca.gov/disability/SDI_Online.htm.

Childcare: Financial assistance for childcare is available through FMLA: www.dol.gov/agencies/whd/pandemic/fcra-employee-paid-leave or IMACA: coronavirus.monocounty.ca.gov/pages/residents#resources.
