## Reindeer

### Materials Needed:

- Candy Cane (1 per ornament)
- Googly Eyes (2 per ornament)
- Pom-pom (1 per ornament)
- Pipe Cleaner (any color you desire!)
- String (optional)

#### **Instructions:**

- Turn your candy cane, so the curved top faces you, this will be the reindeer's face (Don't forget to keep the wrapper on!)
- Glue 2 eyes and a pom-pom, for the reindeer's nose, onto the candy cane
- Twist pipe cleaner around the top of the candy cane, these will be the reindeer's antlers
- Tie a piece of string behind the antlers if you would like to hang your reindeer up!



## Snowman

#### Materials Needed:

- Poster Board
- Construction Paper
- Felt or Fabric
- Cotton Balls
- Markers

- Scissors
- Yarn
- Glue
- Buttons



#### Instructions

- Trace and cut the shape of a snowman on a poster board.
- Cut a hat for your snowman out of construction paper, don't forget to decorate!
- Glue cotton balls all over the body of your snowman.
- Use buttons to make a face for your snowman
- Tie a piece of felt or fabric around your snowman's neck to make a scarf
- Loop a piece of yarn to the back of the snowman's hat. Now you can hang your snowman up!
